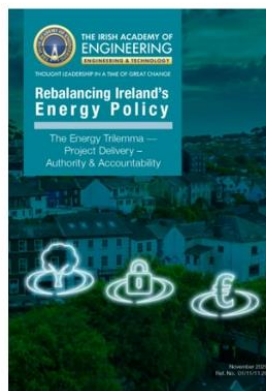

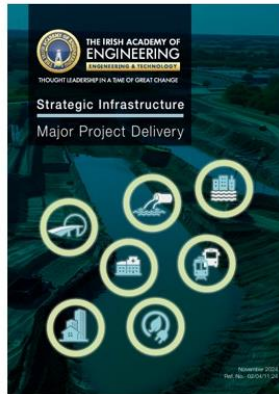
ACADEMY NEWS –5th December 2025 – Media reports on Academy publications.

The publication in November 2025 of the report on [Rebalancing Ireland's Energy policy](#) received widespread media coverage. A new era in delivering essential public infrastructure



The Government on 3rd December 2025 published the [Accelerating Infrastructure - Report and Action Plan](#) , which reflects many of the recent proposals by the Academy, to help drive the efficient delivery of infrastructure across Ireland.

The Action Plan addresses the 12 barriers to infrastructure development that were highlighted in the Report on Stakeholder Consultation and Engagement with Emerging Themes on Infrastructure, published in July.

Thirty specific, time-bound measures have been designed to remove barriers. These actions represent a transformative approach to streamlining development processes and significantly reducing delivery timelines.
